The song follows Svealand's gentle passage from summer into autumn. Golden leaves, morning frost, mist, and the first fire in the hearth create a melancholy beauty in which the soul of the land rests until spring returns.



When the North Calls

A broken man finds his way back into the light through the love of a woman who helps him build a family and a new life. When the world grows harsh again, they follow the call of the North and finally find peace, freedom, and a lasting home in Svealand.



The Silence of Svealand

In the winter silence of Svealand, snow-covered forests, frozen lakes, and fading animal tracks become images of profound calm. Despite the cold and darkness, the glowing hearth, children playing on the ice, and the vast landscape create a deep sense of belonging.



When the Gods Fall Silent

The Norse gods enter their final battle as the sun, moon, and nine worlds fall into the fire of Ragnarök. Yet from ash, soil, and silence, new life begins, while the memory of the old gods continues to live within humanity.



Ronja - Daughter of the Wild

Ronja grows up as a child of the forest among animals, spirits, storms, and wild mountains. Her bond with Birk overcomes the hatred between their families and reveals that love and freedom can be stronger than fear, pride, and inherited conflict.



Santa Lucia - Sång från mörkret

In the deepest darkness of the Swedish winter, Lucia appears as a bearer of light, warmth, and hope. Her quiet passage through snow and shadow reminds us that even a single flame can offer comfort and guide people home.



Twelve Nights (of Omen and Bones)

During the twelve mysterious nights between the old year and the new, the boundaries between mortals, gods, the dead, and the spirit world begin to dissolve. Smoke, dreams, animal voices, and the Wild Hunt reveal guilt, fate, and possible paths into the coming year.



Under Northern Stars (Jag önskar dig en fridfull jul)

*A gentle Christmas song about a family finding warmth, gratitude, and togetherness
beneath the northern stars. While snow and winter winds rule outside, their home
becomes a place of love and peace.*



Under norra stjärnorna (Jag önskar dig en fridfull jul)

The Swedish version portrays a peaceful Christmas evening filled with candlelight, children's laughter, and family closeness. Beneath the clear northern sky, hearts come together and remember what truly gives life meaning.



Spring over Långban

After a long winter, the lakes, forests, and old mines of Långban awaken once more. Meltwater, returning birds, Walpurgis fires, and the first warm sunlight connect the village's mineral-rich past with a hopeful new beginning.



Midsommar - Beneath the Sleepless Sun

Långban celebrates Midsommar with flower crowns, a decorated maypole, dancing, and shared songs beneath a sun that barely sets. For the narrator, the celebration becomes a moment of profound gratitude in which every long road ends and Svealand finally becomes home.



Twelve Nights (of Omen and Bones) - Extended Edition

The extended version ventures even deeper into the unsettling world of the twelve nights, where the Wild Hunt crosses the winter sky and the dead draw close to the living. Rituals, omens, and personal reckonings cleanse the old year before the house, its people, and the world awaken in the light of a new dawn.
